You will work with an academic to develop and co-deliver seminars, workshops, and lectures with a strong practice focus. You can expect to undertake 1-2 hours of preparation for every hour of co-teaching and attending the agreed session(s).

These opportunities will help to cultivate a learning culture in your organisation and enhance your own continuing professional development and experience. You will need to be released from work to allow you to participate and no additional payment is allocated.
